Let's cross Brexit together

Your new responsibilities for crossing the smart border



If you are carrying goods (Import-Export-Transit)

You'll need an International Consignment Note (CMR), any relevant mandatory licences, and the Master Reference Number (MRN) from a customs declaration

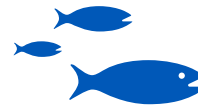


If you are carrying Sanitary & Phytosanitary (SPS) goods

A pre-notification is required and/or additional inspection at designated locations

If you are carrying seafood products

You'll need a specific authorization and an inspection



If your vehicle is empty

You'll need the relevant licenses to cross the border



In case of a Brexit without an agreement (or a 'new deal' scenario), it would result in new customs formalities and controls at border crossing points, which means you must take into account

new responsibilities. To avoid experiencing delays or getting stuck at the border, make sure you have fully completed the mandatory import, export or transit formalities.
